Support Casa del Migrante A.C. is the oldest and largest shelter for male migrants and deportees in Tijuana, offering services like shelter, food, and clothing, as well as a wide range of programs to aid in the social reintegration of migrants. Support Instituto de Madre Assunta A.C. is the “sister-shelter” of Casa del Migrante, serving women and children migrants. It was the first in Tijuana to develop a method for the provision of dignified assistance to women and children who have been displaced after deportation from the U.S. or are migrating from central Mexico. As of this week, the shelter is filled beyond double their capacity, but unwilling to close its doors to anyone in need.
